
Points, Patches, and Awards

Point Allocation

- **All trip leaders and co-leaders—20 points per day.** Only one trip leader and one co-leader will be designated on each trip. Anyone listed as a co-leader must be able to take over in a trip leader's absence. All trip leaders' family members receive double points, but only two individuals are to be listed as leader and co-leader.
- **All participants—10 points per day.**
- **All instructors for training sessions—20 points per day, student participants—10 points per day.**
- **Clean up trips—Leaders 40 points, participants 20 points per day.**
- **Scouting trips—10 points per day for leaders and participants.**

Patches

- **Leader Patch:** All designated trip leaders and co-leaders will be awarded a one-time trip leader patch.
- **Junior Trip Leader Patch:** Junior Trip Leader is defined as 17 and under. A one-time patch will be awarded for Junior Trip Leader.
- **100-Mile Patch:** All members who earn 100 or more points for the season will be awarded a "100-Mile" patch for the season.
- **River Rat Patch:** Members who earn a 100-mile patch for the first time will be awarded a "River Rat" patch.
- **Clean-Up Patch:** All members who participate in a clean-up trip during the season will be awarded a "Clean-Up" patch.

Annual Awards

- **Paddler of the Year** awarded to the top point earner, except that an individual will not receive this award more than once in five years.
- **Top Point Earner** awarded to the individual with the most points for the season except when that individual is Paddler of the Year.
- **Most Trips Led** awarded to the trip leader who leads the most trips for the season.
- **Conservationist of the Year** awarded to the person who leads the most clean up trips during the season.
- **Rookie of the Year** awarded to the new member with the most river points earned for the season.
